

Instructions for Local NMI President's Report (XL-4)

1. Report NMI members (Include Adult, Youth, and Children.)
 - a. NMI members—members of the Church of the Nazarene. (Give this number to your pastor for his/her report.)
 - b. NMI associate members—non-church members. (Give this number to your pastor.)
 - c. For total NMI members, add 1a and 1b.
 - d. Total NMI members reported last year should be available from the previous year's report or from the previous year's district journal.
 - e. Net gain/loss: If the total members is more this year than last year, you have a net gain (+). If your members this year is less than reported last year, you have a net loss (-).
2. **Yes or No.** Is your church **praying** for global concerns—missionaries, countries, disasters, needs of other people around the globe?
3. **Yes or No.** Is your church **discipling** children/youth and adults in mission by inviting them to mission services and encouraging them to explore mission possibilities?
4. **Yes or No.** Is your church **giving** 100% of your World Evangelism Fund (WEF)? Check with your church treasurer and/or pastor.
5. **Yes or No.** Need to mark Yes to **all 4 (a,b,c, and d)** below to mark Yes on **educating**.
 - a. Used **multimedia missions resources** (such as *World Mission DVD*, missions Web sites, videos, Nazarene Communications News, etc.) **and/or utilized missions publications and communications** (such as adult mission education, youth mission education, children's mission education, *International Mission Education Journal*, *Mission Connection*, *Global Glimpses*, *Nazarene Compassionate Ministries* magazine, *Holiness Today*, missionaries' newsletters, regional newsletters, etc.).
 - b. Promoted **NMI missions books/tapes/CDs**. Report the number of books read.
 - c. Participated in **missions service projects** (such as Work & Witness, Youth in Mission, Youthserve, CAUSE, Nazarene Compassionate Ministries centers, Good Samaritan churches, community projects, etc.) and/or **hands-on missions activities** (Crisis Care Kits, School Pal-Paks, relief shipments, LINKS packages, unofficial LINKS, etc.)
 - d. Attended one or more services with a **missions speaker** (local, zone/area, district, and/or regional events; faith promise) and/or provided interaction with a missions speaker (district teen/children's camps, missions events, district NMI convention, missions workshops, etc.).
6. **Yes or No.** If you marked **Yes** on 2, 3, 4, and 5, then mark **Yes**, you are a Mission Priority One church.
7. **Yes or No.** Overpaid WEF goal by 3% or \$1,000, whichever is less. Check with your NMI or church treasurer.
8. **Yes or No.** Sent 100% of your district budget to your district. Check with your local NMI or church treasurer.
9. a. **Yes or No.** Sent 100% of your LINKS. Check with your local NMI or church treasurer.
b. Number of individual packages sent to missionaries and/or mission fields. (If none, show 0.)
10. **Yes or No.** Sent 100% of Missionary Christmas Fund. Check with your local NMI or church treasurer.
11. **Yes or No.** Alabaster offering is usually promoted in February and September. Any amount sent is counted as participation.
12. **Yes or No.** World Mission Broadcast offering is usually promoted in June. Any amount sent is counted as participation.
13. a. **Yes or No.** Nazarene Compassionate Ministries (NCM) is usually promoted in December. (NCM Fund, Child Sponsorship, Crisis Care Kits, disaster response, etc., count as participation.)
b. Report number of individual Crisis Care Kits sent.
c. Report number of individual School Pal-Paks sent.
14. **Yes or No.** Ordered Memorial Rolls and/or Distinguished Service Awards, sent an offering, or encouraged the use of "Gifts from the Heart. Any or all count as participation."
 - a. Print or type the name of the recipients of Memorial Roll certificates.
 - b. Print or type the name of the recipients of Distinguished Service Awards.
