Dear Pastor/NYI President,

Enclosed you will find information and applications for Youth Camp 2009 (junior high and senior high camp combined). Both camps will run simultaneously during the week of June 8-12, 2009. Each camp will have its own schedule with combined services.

In order to make this week possible we need your help promoting and recruiting volunteers. Every church sending students must send a sponsor(s) or make arrangements with another church. Our camper to sponsor ratio is a minimum of 10:1. If you have a large group, please send one sponsor for every ten students. Pay attention to your group's gender breakdown and send sponsors that meet your group's needs.

To further insure the safety of your students, we have created additional policies concerning camp visitors. Please inform your students and adults of these changes.

- Non-paid student visitors will be allowed on camp property only during evening services.
- All adult visitors must check in and be approved by camp director.

Campers' room assignments will be made prior to the start of camp. Students are asked for their roommate request(s) on the application. We will do our best to meet their request, however, there is no guarantee. Walk-ups and late registers will be extremely less likely to have their request honored. **Early Bird cost is \$135, and the Early Bird pre-registration deadline is May 22, 2009. Cost after May 22, 2009 is \$155. The absolute registration deadline is June 1, 2009.** Please assist us in registering students and sponsors by this date.

Additional camp information (schedule) will be sent to churches prior to camp. We appreciate your consideration and assistance with this year's camp.
